Edmentum Student Expectations

Edmentum offers students two asynchronous options when taking our courses. One is with an Edmentum 'EdOptions Academy' instructor and the other is with their local district/school teacher.

Student Commitments: If the course is taken through an Edmentum EdOptions

Academy instructor; there is no specific time of day a student must be logged in when completing their courseware. (It is highly recommended that a student spend at least 50 minutes per day on each class, 5 days a week in order to stay on track.) Students are given a maximum of 18 weeks to complete a one-half credit course during the fall and spring semesters. If chosen course(s) is taken through local district/school instructor; they may require specific login times of day (I.e. during school hours within a school lab setting, etc.)

<u>Communication Expectations:</u> Students can reach out to their EdOptions Academy teacher through phone, email or designated collaborative learning/teaching tools at any time. Our instructors will respond within 24 hours to asynchronous communications sent by any student. Parents and Guardians can contact the EdOptions Academy Instructors or Program Manager at any time for their students specific class concerns and/or questions.
