



The **Missouri Virtual Instruction Program (MoVIP)** is a tuition-based program which offers online courses to K-12 public, private and homeschool students in Missouri. MoVIP gives students equal access to a wide range of high-quality courses taught by Missouri certified teachers. The program provides an interactive online learning environment that can be accessed anytime, anywhere.



The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and the State Board of Education oversee MoVIP administration and quality assurance of course content and delivery.

Availability

There is no limit on the availability of tuition-based courses during the school year.

A limited number of course registrations, funded by the state of Missouri, are available at no cost to medically fragile students each year. More information about applying for these state-funded courses can be found at movip.org.

Summer school courses are based on demand and availability and are tuition-based only.
