- Foreign language courses for elementary, middle and high school students

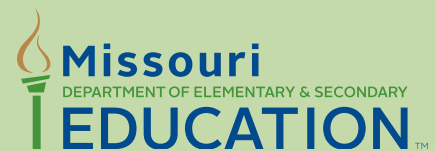

Summer school registration for the Missouri Virtual Instruction Program (MoVIP) is underway! MoVIP offers virtual online courses for Missouri students. Students can take an entire course from any internet-connected computer, available 24-hours a day, seven days a week. MoVIP is a K-12 program. Students must provide their own internet access and computer.

Summer classes through MoVIP offer students the opportunity to hold a summer job and still take classes. Smaller school districts are able to offer more courses with MoVIP, and, in certain circumstances, local districts may agree to pay students' tuition.

Students must register one week prior to the start of class.
